## 3. Conditions

## 3.1 General conditions

- Pearl oysters or pearl oyster spat shall only be sold by the licensee to the holder of a pearling licence under the Act or as otherwise approved in writing by the Executive Director.
- 2) No pearl oysters shall be exported from or transported out of Western Australia without prior written authorisation from the Executive Director.

## 3.2 Propagation

- 1) No more than 50 pearl oysters may be held by the licensee or at the hatchery at any one time as broodstock.
- The licensee shall comply with the disease management protocol requirements set and varied from time to time by the Executive Director of Fisheries.
- 3) Unless otherwise authorised in writing, no pearl oysters or pearl oyster spat shall be disposed of in any manner or by any other means to any other person, other than a person who holds a pearling licence issued under the *Pearling Act 1990* of Western Australia.
- 4) Unless otherwise approved by the EPA, all wastewater generated from the hatchery shall be filtered through sand or treated with chlorine or another method of wastewater disposal approved by the Chief Inspector of Stock.
